DESCRIPTION

It is used before the application of a Guard Industry protection product to prepare the skin of the concrete and thus facilitate the good impregnation of the finishing product.

Guard Cleaner[®] Maintenance can also be used for the cleaning, care and daily maintenance of concrete protected with a protective product from the ProtectGuard[®] et ProtectGuard[®] Color. It helps to keep the concrete clean and looking new without damaging the concrete or the protection.

Guard Cleaner[®] Maintenance is much less aggressive than other products on the market (it is not classified and labelled as corrosive or irritant). It has

ADVANTAGES AND CHARACTERISTICS

- Powerful, fast acting cleaner.

Environmentally friendly and ecological:

- Water-based product, soda and potash-free.

HOW TO USE

• Always carry out a test on the substrate before application.

Recommendation:

- <u>Cleaning before protection:</u> Use the product undiluted.
- <u>Maintenance of a protected surface</u>:
- Dilute I part product to 9 parts water.
- Moisten the surface to be cleaned beforehand.
- Apply the product generously to the surface to be treated.
- Leave to act for 15 to 30 minutes depending on the dirt to be removed.
- Do not let the product dry before rinsing.
- Rinse the entire surface with a cold or hot water pressure washer for greater effectiveness.

- It is not necessary to neutralise the treated surface.

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT

Clean used tools and equipment with water immediately after use.

STORAGE

- Store in a dry place at a temperature between 5°C and 30°C.
- Shelf life: 48 months from the date of manufacture, in unopened original packaging.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Protect metal surfaces (aluminium, zinc, tin, copper, light alloys, etc.).
- For a perfect application, Guard Cleaner[®] Maintenance should only be used when substrate temperature is between 5°C and 30°C.
- Do not apply in rain or very hot weather.
- Ideal air temperature between 5°C and 30°C.
- Do not mix with other products.

HEALTH / SAFETY

- <u>Breathing protection</u>: No breathing protection equipment is required under normal use conditions with suitable ventilation.
- <u>Hand protection</u>: Wear household rubber gloves.
- <u>Skin protection</u>: Wear protective clothing over exposed areas of skin.
